The clearest means of being accountable to your membership is to be a well-run, efficient organization.

Perhaps you can review the following:

Self-Assessment: Does your board know how the organization is perceived by its membership? Does your board have a formal plan for communicating with those outside the organization? Has your board developed a management plan that includes a communication strategy? How does your board involve outside members in planning or program development? Does your board reflect the membership it serves?

Fundraising: Does your board understand how each program or project affects the need for raising funds? Does your board use the budget process to inform its fundraising planning? Has your board developed a long term fundraising strategy? Is your entire board committed to active participation in fundraising? Do you have a well qualified, proactive fundraising or resource development committee?

Financial Oversight: How often does the board review income statements, balance sheets, statements of cash flow, budget versus actual reports, cash flow projections and records of major expenditures? Can the board interpret these reports and act upon the results?

Accountability: Does your board have standards of conduct for board members and staff? Upon joining the board, does each board member acknowledge, in writing, an understanding of and a willingness to

abide by these policies?

Leadership: When considered together, does your board have sufficient technical expertise to set policy for and implement the programs that support the vision and mission of the organization? Are the roles and responsibilities of board and staff members clearly understood? Are they reviewed and updated on a regular basis?

I hope that you all have seen the new Ohio USBC WBA Website. If you haven't, please take the time to visit it at www.ohiowba.com. The new website will be updated more frequently and hopefully it will be informative. We welcome your comments and hope that you will provide them to us so that we will know what you think of the new site.

I would like to encourage every local association to have at least one representative attend the USBC Workshop that we are sponsoring in Bellville, on Saturday, September 22nd. The topics for this workshop should be very informative and useful to every local association in the State of Ohio.

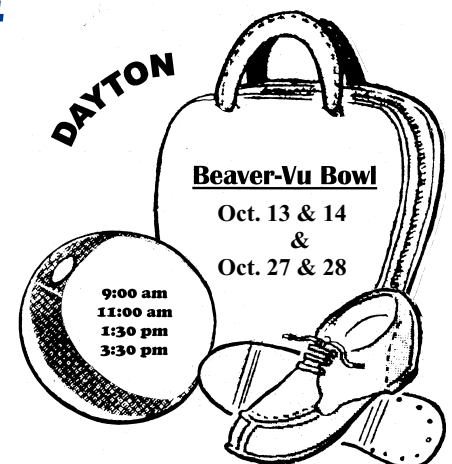
Entry forms will be available through all local associations or on the Ohio USBC WBA website OHIOWBA.COM. Entries close December 15, 2007.

The 2007 Ohio USBC Women's Bowling Association Championship Tournament has come to a close.

I would like to extend my personal thanks to the Warren and Youngstown USBC WBAs for their help and support. Three years of hard work and preparation has paid off. The result: a successful tournament. Also, I would be remiss if I did not recognize all the "behind the scenes" people. All the monitors, center personnel, photographers, office staff, friends and family made everything run smoothly and with very few glitches. A huge thank you goes to the husbands who were "bowling widowers" for twelve weekends. However, my biggest thank you goes to Lois Caylor for again this year managing the doubles/singles center. As I think back on all the tournaments I have participated in, I can't remember going to the doubles/singles center and not seeing Lois there. They kind of go hand in hand. Hey Lois, how about Toledo???

Now, looking forward to the 2008 tournament in Toledo, you will see a few changes.

The bowlers spoke and we listened. We will now accept Visa, MasterCard and Discover for payment of any of our Ohio USBC WBA functions. The office was "charge card ready" July 1, 2007. There will be a separate form mailed with all tournament entries. Once the authorization has been received from your financial institution, the charge payment form will be shredded. We are prepared to

take every precaution necessary for your safety.

In addition, the host association is always scheduled last after all out-of-town bowlers are scheduled. Beginning in Toledo, we will be offering (for the host association only) four (4) Friday night squads; two team and two doubles/singles. This will hopefully alleviate the host association getting scheduled on all "the bad squads". They will also be available to work the tournament on Saturday and Sunday, or they can choose one of the Friday squads.

Our third change for this year is the entry deadline. Bowlers have continually told us that they have to "put out" too much money for tournament entries at the beginning of the bowling season. Once again, in order to help the bowler, we have changed the entry deadline to December 1. That is fifteen (15) extra days to get a team together.

The Ohio USBC Women's Bowling Association Board of Directors believe these changes are in the best interest of the tournament. We have also re-instituted the tournament review committee to address other issues that bowlers have talked to us about. You will be kept up to date when and if any further changes are made.

I am looking forward to working with the Greater Toledo USBC and to seeing all of you at next year's tournament. So ladies, start now getting your team together and let's all **GO APE IN 2008**.

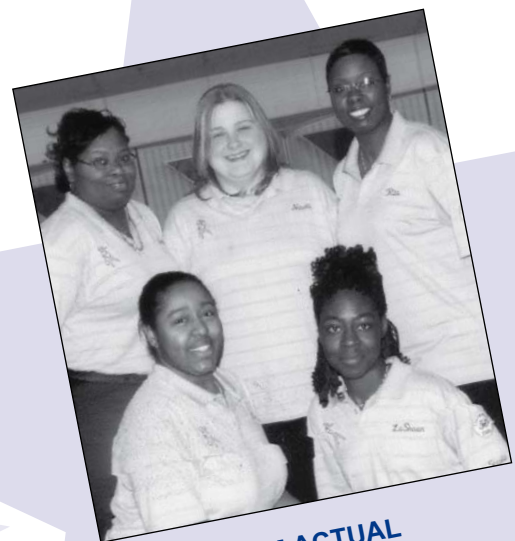

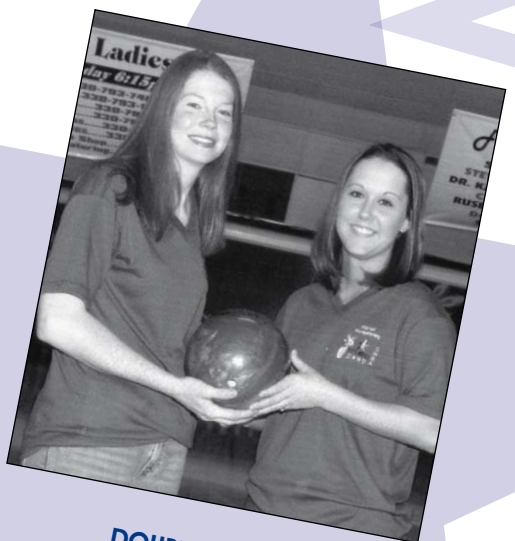
