Kathy Coombs is a member of the Greater Toledo USBC and has been a WIBC/USBC member for thirty years.

She has had twenty-one 300 games and eight 800 plus series and one hundred and fifty 700 plus series.

She has maintained a 200 plus average since 1998. Her highest average was a 232.

Kathy started bowling in the Toledo youth program and graduated to adult leagues in the 1982-83 season and almost immediately made a name for herself. She has accumulated six ToledoWBA/Greater Toledo USBC championship titles. She won singles actual in 1991 and doubles actual in 1986, 1987, 1995, and 2010. She is the actual all events winner in 1995 and 2010.

In the 2011 Bowling Green USBC tournament she was a member of the winning team actual, team handicap, singles actual, doubles actual and all events. She was also the actual all events winner in 2009.

Kathy was a member of the Ohio USBC WBA Actual Division Team Champions in 2011.

She has competed in several Ohio WBA/Ohio USBC WBA Queens Tournaments, finishing third in 2005, sixth in 1996 and thirteenth in 2008.

She was the recipient of the WIBC Bev Ortner Award in 1998 for having the highest ladies series in the nation with an 846.

She was inducted into the Greater Toledo Youth Hall of Fame in 2003, the Toledo Hall of Fame in 1998 and the Ohio Bowling Hall of Fame in 2012, all for Superior Performance.

She is currently serving on the Greater Toledo USBC Board of Directors.

This outstanding record most certainly assures Kathy Coombs admission to the Ohio USBC WBA Hall of Fame for her many SUPERIOR PERFORMANCES.
